Michael M.I. Abecassis, MD, MBA

Dr. Michael Abecassis began his clinical career in 1991 at the University of Iowa as assistant professor of surgery and director of liver transplantation and hepatobiliary surgery. In 1993, he was recruited to Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine to launch its liver transplant program. A pioneer in surgical innovation and transplant care, Dr. Abecassis has been continuously funded by the NIH for over 20 years, leading research from viral latency to molecular biomarkers in transplant recipients. He has contributed extensively to NIH study sections and panels in transplantation and virology.
