Keynote Speaker: Brandy Shufutinsky

Brandy Shufutinsky leads the Education and National Security Program at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies, where she studies what American schools teach children about Jews and Israel, and who decides it. She testified before the United States House subcommittee on K-12 education about the roots of antisemitism in American schools, and traced how teacher training, outside funding and curriculum development organizations shape what reaches a classroom. Most of us have never seen that material. Our children and grandchildren sit with it every week. Her writing appears in Newsweek, Jewish Journal, The Jerusalem Post, Sapir and JNS, and she holds a doctorate in international and multicultural education.
